

Chariton Community School Board
Special Session
May 28, 2020

The Chariton Community School District met in special session on May 28, 2020, in the Administration Office Board Room. The meeting was also available to access via Zoom, an online virtual meeting platform. The regular meeting was called to order by Board President, Dusty Cain at 7:05 pm. An exempt session was held prior to the board meeting at 6:30 pm. Board members present were Sarah Willis, Vice President, Kyle Curtis, Jamie Aulwes and Casey DeHoedt, all via Zoom. No one was absent. Also present were Superintendent Larry Achenbach, and Board Secretary, Kylie Dittmer.

Board Agenda

Mr. Aulwes made a motion to approve the agenda. Motion carried, 4-0.

Discussion Items

Mr. Achenbach led a discussion about employee vacations. Due to COVID-19, employees who have continued to work, will be allowed to carryover no more than five days of vacation. This will have to be used by the end of July.

Mr. Achenbach and Mr. Milledge led a discussion about the shortened 2019-2020 Baseball and Softball seasons.

Action Items

Ms. DeHoedt made a motion to approve the 9th grade Softball Coach contract for Tanna Seufferer for 2019-2020. Motion carried, 4-0.

Ms. Willis made a motion to approve the Juvenile Court Liaison contract for Molly Cusic for the 2020-2021 school year. The state will pay for half of the contract, not to exceed \$32,758. The total contract is \$65,516. Motion carried, 4-0.

Ms. DeHoedt made a motion to approve the Classified Staff contracts for 2020-2021. The contract included a 2% salary increase. Motion carried, 4-0.

Mr. Curtis made a motion to approve salaries for the Administrators, Directors and other support staff for 2020-2021. The new salaries were approved as follows, with no change to contract length: Derek Phillips, \$94,656; Josh Morgan, \$94,656; Anson Bonte, \$98,316; Tim Milledge, \$100,025; Tracy Hall, \$115,439; Tianna Goddard, \$50,000; Kylie Dittmer, \$62,571; Corey Johnson, \$61,879; Becca Bittner, \$47,066; Pam Buck, \$45,760; Peggy White, \$16.42/hour. Motion carried, 4-0.

As a note, Mr. Cain abstained from voting on all action items.

No action was taken on the final action item, to consider the Baseball/Softball season for 2020-2021 as the board decided to move forward with the season.

Mr. Curtis made a motion to adjourn. Motion carried, 4-0. The time was 7:35 pm.
