Regular Session
January 9, 2023

The Chariton Community School District met in regular session on January 9, 2023, in the Administration Office Board Room. A public hearing was held at 6:30 pm to receive public comment regarding the redistricting of board seats. Several members of the public addressed the board. The regular meeting was called to order by Board President, Casey DeHoedt at 6:55 pm. Board members present were Sarah Willis, Vice President, Jamie Aulwes and Dustin Shivvers. Kyle Curtis was absent. Also present were Superintendent Brad Baker and Board Secretary and Business Manager, Kylie Dittmer.

Mr. Aulwes made a motion to approve the resolution to adopt redistricting plan eliminating boundaries and elect all board members at large following the 2020 federal census. Mr. Shivvers seconded. Motion carried, 4-0.

Ms. Willis made a motion to approve the Modified Allowable Growth Dropout Prevention Application, in the amount of \$254,452. Mr. Shivvers seconded. Motion carried, 4-0.

Mr. Aulwes made a motion to approve a board resolution to approve the Revenue Purpose Statement, order an election on a Revenue Purpose Statement to authorize expenditures from revenue received from the state Secure an Advanced Vision for Education Fund and order the publication of a notice of election to fill a board vacancy. Ms. Willis seconded. Motion carried, 4-0.

Mr. Shivers made a motion to approve the specifications for bidding and public hearing date for HVAC at Van Allen and Columbus Elementary Schools. The date of the public hearing will be February 20, 2023. Mr. Aulwes seconded. Motion carried, 4-0.

Mr. Shivers made a motion to approve the first reading of the Preschool Handbook. Ms. Willis seconded. Motion carried, 4-0.
