## Chariton Community School Board Regular Session October 9, 2023

The Chariton Community School District met in regular session on October 9, 2023 in the Administration Office Board Room.

## **Action Items**

Mr. Shivvers made a motion to approve the modified allowable growth and supplemental aid for our special education deficit, in the amount of \$255,820.08, for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. Mr. Aulwes seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mrs. Shelton made a motion to approve the *first* reading of Board Policies 700-704.5. These policies were reviewed by the Iowa School Board Association and the finance and policy committee.

Mr. Aulwes made a motion to approve the *first* reading of *new* Board Policies 705.1R1 and 705.1R2. These policies are needed to receive funds from the federal grant- Safe Funds for Schools. Our school attorneys have reviewed and approved. Mrs. Willis seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mr. Shivvers made a motion to approve the School Advisory Committee Members (SIAC) for 2023-2024. Mrs. Shelton seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mrs. Willis made a motion to approve the sharing agreement with Wayne Community School District for girls high school wrestling. Both schools' Athletic Directors and Superintendents agreed to the terms.

Mrs. Shelton made a motion to approve the Limited English Proficiency (LEP) allowable costs of \$8,473.00. Mr. Shivvers seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mr. Aulwes made a motion to approve the Base Bid, for the Middle School Water Mitigation Project, in the amount of \$599,642, to be awarded to Joiner Construction, with the proposed Substantial Completion date December 31, 2023 and the Final Completion date of May 15, 2024.

Mr. Baker and the Board had a discussion about his Superintendent Goals.

Mr. Baker gave an update about our FY22 Audit being unavailable. We are getting in touch weekly to check the status.

Mr. Baker spoke briefly about Arcadia Towers approaching us about the possibility of leasing our ground for a cell tower(s).
