Admin Reports	Mr. Prewitt reviewed budget quick look. The local tax money has begun to come in and the revenues and expenditures are back in line with one another.
	Mrs. Butler, elementary principal, reported that the Leader in Me coach was in the district all day on Friday, January 9 <sup>th</sup> . He was very positive about the program and left the staff feeling very good about what they have been doing. The next leader awards assembly will be Friday, January30th. The elementary has partnered with the Mid-Continent library to encourage reading. January 21 <sup>st</sup> , all students scoring Advanced on the Maps and EOC's will be honored at 6:00 p.m. The education foundation awarded a mini-grant to Tawana Berens at the elementary. Seven projects will be funded or partially funded by the foundation and

supporters. Summer school will tentatively be held May 26<sup>th</sup> – June 19<sup>th</sup>. Winter Assessments are this week. The Map testing window is March 30<sup>th</sup> through the end of school. Mrs. Butler spoke to the board about the potential of using a Standards' based grading system.

Mr. Tarwater reported that Angela Gottesburen, librarian was the minigrant recipient at the high school. Heather Hill and Mr. Brendal/Mr. Brown will also receive some funding from the foundation for their projects. Staff from Adrian visited Lone Jack to see how the Google Classroom is being used.
