IX. Action Items

- 1. Approve an early resignation incentive of 2,500 dollars to certified teachers and administrators who intend to resign effective at the end of the 2024-25 school year. To qualify, they must email the Superintendent or deliver it to Central Office staff by 4:00 PM on January 8, 2024. A lump sum of \$2,500 will be paid on their May payroll check.
- Consider approving Mid-Term Graduate Student Requests The district has received twelve
 (12) requests for mid-term graduation. These students are Drake Schultz, Cayden Schlutz,
 Skyler Storm, Jocelyn Pierschbacher, Valentyna Riasichenko, Maylea Vandyne, Mark
 Riasichenko, Austen Hampton, Cassidy Saffell, Alexis Halsted, Kendall Watson, and Aaliyah
 Richard.
- 3. Approve the district's Reconsideration Team, required by legislation, tasked with reviewing library material and resources when a formal request for consideration is made by a public member concerning the content of our library materials. The proposed Reconsideration Team meets the state requirements with representation from a parent/community, staff, and administration.
- 4. Appoint a representative to serve on the joint Community Center Board as indicated in the 28E agreement between the Chariton Community Schools, the City of Chariton, and the Foundation (Johnson Foundation, Hy-Vee Stores, Inc.) as listed in the agreement.
- 5. Approve request for modified allowable growth from SBRC. The district has the option of requesting additional modified allowable growth for English Learners (EL) Instruction. This is not money/cash, this is spending authority which allows the Board to levy for these additional expenses that the district will incur. This year we are requesting \$6,965 for EL.
- 6. Approve request for modified allowable growth from SBRC. The district has the option of requesting additional modified allowable growth for Increased Enrollment. This is not money/cash, this is spending authority which allows the Board to levy for these additional expenses that the district will incur. This year we are requesting \$96,259.00 for an increase in enrollment.
- 7. Approve request for modified supplemental amount (spending authority) from SBRC. The district has the option of requesting an additional modified supplemental amount if the current year's Open Enrollment Out (OEO) was not on prior year's headcount. This is not money/cash, this is spending authority. This year we are requesting \$8,362 for Open Enrollment Out.
- 8. Approve the <u>District Delivered Service Delivery Plan for Special Education Team</u>, (DDSDP). The Chariton Community School District gathered input from various board-approved team members, including representatives from the CCSD administration, general and special education teachers, paraprofessionals, parents, Great Prairie AEA, and other district-certified staff. Iowa Code, Department of Education resources, sample district plans, and team member input were used to fulfill the requirements of the plan. This plan has been collaboratively developed to ensure that the needs of all students are met.
- 9. Approve the second reading of board policies 402-402.6, 403.1-403.6, 404-404.4 and 405-405.9.

- 12. Approve Depository Limits
