EMPLOYEE INJURY ON THE JOB Revised: 12-12-19

When an employee becomes seriously injured on the job, the employee's supervisor will attempt to notify amember of the family, or an individual of close relationship, as soon as the employee's supervisor becomes aware of the injury.

If possible, an employee may administer emergency or minor first aid. An injured employee will be turned overto the care of the employee's family or qualified medicalemployees as quickly as possible. The school district is not responsible for medical treatment of an injured employee.

It is the responsibility of the employee injured on the jobto inform the employee's immediate supervisor within twenty-four hours of the occurrence. It is the responsibility of the employee's immediate supervisor tofile an accident report within twenty-four hours after the employee reported the injury.

It is the responsibility of the Worker's CompCoordinator to file worker's comp claims.
