

## GENERAL ORGANIZATION

Starting with the 1998-1999 school year the schools of the District shall be organized into levels of instruction as follows:

1. Elementary schools: The elementary schools shall consist of Kindergarten and grades one through five.

The organization of Kindergarten shall be on the basis of alternate full-day instruction. Where there are not sufficient students to warrant two sections of Kindergarten in a school, the Kindergarten shall be held two days per week plus alternating Fridays.

2. Middle School: The middle school shall consist of grades six through eight.
3. Senior High School: The senior high school shall consist of grades nine through twelve.

Each school building shall have a principal responsible for the administration and management of the school building
