Please consider making use of the public library a part of your weekly routine to support your child's reading.

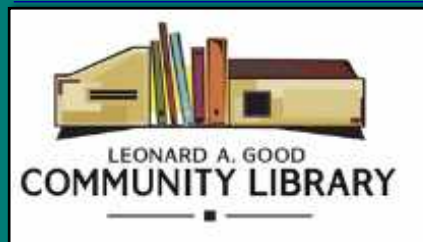
