

The Board of Education of the Corning Community Schools met in regular session on Monday, June 16, 2025. The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by the President, Staci Venteicher. Present were: Howard Anderson, Adam Boswell, Stephanie Hodapp, Trent Roberts, and Staci Venteicher. Also present were: Superintendent Chris Fenster, Board Secretary Jodi Lyddon, Elementary Principal Allison Thomas, Adam Hawxbby, Ryan Nelson, Josh Keul, David Mullnix, Chris Gilbert, Burt Peckham, Janice Leonard, and Brandon Templeton.

Adam Boswell read the mission statement. Moved by Hodapp seconded by Boswell approving the consent agenda. Carried Unanimously.

Estes Construction shared updates on the construction project. Ryan Nelson presented change orders: #047 – Kitchen New Wall Finishes and #048 Baseball/Softball Electrical Fixes.

Mayor Chris Gilbert and City Council Members Burt Peckham and Janice Leonard asked the board for consideration of repair on Loomis Street. Discussion was held with the board.

Administrator reports were presented. The board discussed the request from the Methodist Church for repair of two HVAC units. The board decided they need documentation from the church on the \$10,000 deposit. The board continued discussion on Loomis Street repairs. The board decided to seek quotes from Estes Construction on different options for repair and requested follow-up from the city council after their next meeting.

Moved by Boswell seconded by Hodapp approving the 2025-2026 contract with Micayla Vanderhoof as high school tennis coach. Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Anderson seconded by Hodapp approving the 2024-2025 contract with Lisa Sparks as high school mentor. Voting Yes: Anderson, Hodapp, Roberts, and Venteicher. Voting No: None. Boswell abstained.

Moved by Boswell seconded by Hodapp to approve change orders #047 Kitchen Wall Finishes and #048 Baseball/Softball electrical fixes as presented by Estes Construction. Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Boswell seconded by Hodapp approving the quote from FMTC for \$40,000 for fiber optic installation. Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Roberts seconded by Boswell to approve the 2025-2026 school fees as presented. Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Roberts seconded by Boswell approving the 2025-2026 technology purchases as presented by Brandon Templeton. Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Hodapp seconded by Anderson to approve the 2025-2026 MOU with Matura Head Start. Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Boswell seconded by Roberts approving to approve the 2025-2026 SWCC Handbook and Course Catalog. Carried Unanimously.

The Board decided not to pursue the Storm Protection Fund insurance.

Moved by Roberts seconded by Hodapp allowing the board secretary to pay bills through the end of June 2025 due to the fiscal year end. Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Hodapp seconded by Roberts to adjourn the meeting. Carried Unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 9:37 p.m.
