Moved by Hodapp seconded by Roberts to approve contracts offered to Melissa Perrin, Assistant Track Coach and Sydney Dimmler, part-time cook. Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Hodapp seconded by Roberts to vote for John Gambs for the Director District Number 2 Area Education Agency Board of Directors. Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Boswell seconded by Hodapp to accept the bid from Fisher Tracks to complete track maintenance. Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Boswell seconded by Hodapp to approve the graduation requests for Elizabeth Wetzel, Mya Bohn, and Lucas Inman. Carried Unanimously.
