County Free Press on March 26, 2026 and Set the Budget Hearing for April 9, 2026 at 6:45 P.M. in the Middle School Board Room. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION by Mullen, second by Gourley to adjourn the meeting at 7:52 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
