2. Call to Order (Quorum)

The Starmont Community School District Board held a work session on Wednesday, February 4th, in the High School Conference Room. President Puffett called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. 4. Discuss Building Improvements

Board members and visitors discussed necessary building improvements as well as options previously proposed to the district such as rooftop units and airedale units. It was also brought up doing projects in phases as the elementary and middle school are ran on hot water heat out of the middle school boiler room and the high school with steam heat out of the high school boiler room. One of the main priorities is to inspect piping and getting it removed from the tunnels and brought overhead throughout the building as the environment in the tunnels is causing corrosion to the pipes.
