**Call to Order:** Ronnie Boardman called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

**Previous Minutes:** Motion to approve previous minutes from August by Hillary, 2nd by Terry. All in favor.

**Treasurers Report:** Hillary reviewed accounts. Added grant money from a recent grant received from Upper Iowa Mississippi Gaming Corporation. Motion to approve report by Abbie, 2nd by Terry. All in favor.

**AD's Comments-**

1. Checked into the cost of Hudl due to not being able to stream all of the football games because of camera equipment failure. The cost for the subscription will be reduced to \$7830 instead of \$8500. The subscription will be renewed in December.

**Old Business**

1. Baseball Concession Stand: Need to check with the school on winterizing the stand before it freezes.
2. Cement at Football Stand: The grant money was received. Ronnie has given all of the information on measurements and bids to Rob Busch who will begin the process of figuring out the next steps.
3. Revitalizing Football/Track entrance: Austin is working on this.
4. Internet and card reader: Hillary reached out to the school district about options for equipment and what is needed to move forward with this project.

**New Business**

1. Cooler for candy: Hillary proposed the purchase of a small beverage cooler to keep candy in to reduce melting of items during the summer. A motion to approve the purchase of a cooler for \$1412.99 was made by Jen, seconded by Abbie.

2. Concession stand profit and loss and menu adjustment discussion:  
Discussed menu items and making food preparation more streamlined and efficient. Tabled for a future meeting.
3. Photos: The yearbook staff and students would like to have a process to request the use of their photos from events and ensure that their name is credited on the photo. Abbie will check in with the yearbook teacher on how to streamline the process in a timely manner.
4. Meal tickets: 180 meal tickets were given to the school for workers at home events. 91 were redeemed.
5. Track and Cross Country uniforms: Charlie Gruman showed options for new track uniforms and hopes to get a sample by Monday. He would like to purchase 30 for boys and 30 for girls. He thanked the Booster Club for the purchase of t-shirts for state qualifiers. He asked the Booster Club to consider purchasing new warm up sweats (25 for boys and 25 for girls) and will bring a quote for purchase to a future meeting. He also asked for the scholarship point system clarification. Ronnie will check and get back to him. He would like to attend a coaching event out of season and will check on the cost so that the Booster Club can consider paying for a portion or reimbursing.
